<p><b>Always default benefit record number to 0</b> Workforce Administration &gt; Job Information &gt; Job Data &gt; Find Employee &gt; Benefits Program Participation &gt; Benefit Record Number</p>	<p>The Benefits Program Participation page under Job Data has been modified so that the benefits record number will always default to 0.</p> <p>Previously this value could be set to values other than 0 either manually or by the system. Employees with benefits records other than 0 were not having all their benefits deducted during the payroll process.</p>

<p><b>Personal Information – Updating Dummy SSN</b> Navigator &gt; Workforce Administration &gt; Personal Information &gt; Biographical &gt; Modify a Person</p>	<p>Currently, when a 'Dummy Social Security Number (SSN)' is updated with the correct SSN, the record has been saved, and the practitioner goes back into Personal Data to review, the 'Dummy SSN' box is checked again. The new code will allow Shared Service C/HR Practitioner to uncheck the box, open the National ID field for update, and successfully save the correct SSN and ensure the 'Dummy SSN' box is no longer checked.</p> <p><b>Reminder:</b> Institutions should coordinate with SSC to ensure that all other business processes are followed related to update/correction of a Social Security Number.</p>
<p><b>Part-time Professors Graduate Research Assistants (PPGRA) – Load to Job Data</b></p>	<p>Currently additional PPGRA appointments can be entered after the Load to Job Data process is run. The new code will record the</p>



<b>(Currently used by Georgia State University)</b>	run date of the process and PPGRA end users will receive an error explaining that the PPGRA load to job has already been run for the month and no further appointment entries for the month are allowed.
