

## How is USG Fall 2019 IPEDS HR reporting affected by the 2018 SOC changes?

HR IPEDS reports are broken out by IPEDS Occupational Categories which are defined by SOC codes. The USG IPEDS HR survey reports group the employees into these IPEDS occupational categories using a crosswalk table in HRDM, which maps each BCAT to an SOC category, which is then mapped to the **IPEDS Occupational Category (SOC IPEDS CODE)**. The BCAT\_SOC\_CROSSWALK table in USGHR looks like this:

Note that HR IPEDS reporting **does not use the SOC\_CODE**. It uses the direct cross walking from **BCAT to SOC\_IPEDS\_CODE/DESC**.

Revisions were made to the SOC Categories by the Bureau of Labor Statistics in 2018. After analyzing the changes in the 2018 categories, it was found that the only change affecting USG HR IPEDS Survey was the mapping of BCAT 453 to a new SOC IPEDS CODE, which was in a different IPEDS category. The change was as follows:

This excerpt above shows the IPEDS HR Occupational categories used in HR IPEDS Survey and the soc codes (SOC categories) associated with them. It compares 2010 SOC categories to 2018 SOC categories:

All the IPEDS HR Occupational Categories map to the same 2010 SOC codes as 2018 SOC codes (a couple of these codes have different descriptions, but that does not affect the IPEDS HR Occupational categories). Except for Graduate Assistants – Teaching. **This is not a problem for USG since IPEDS occupational categories for Graduate assistants are not defined by SOC categories at USG, but directly by their BCATS.**

As the excerpt also shows, the IPEDS HR Occupational Categories are all defined by the “major groups”, which are denoted by the first two digits of the SOC code, **EXCEPT** for Group 25 (i.e., 250000), which has minor codes (4 digit) and detail codes (6 digit) scattered across several different IPEDS Occupational Categories.

So, with all the changes in 2018 SOC categories, then, for the purpose of USG IPEDS reporting, it seems like we would not have to be concerned with any changes **EXCEPT for changes in Major Groups.**

The minor group “Occupational Health and Safety Specialists and Technicians” (19-5000) moved into major group “Life, Physical and Social Science Occupations” (19-0000) from its former location as a broad occupation, “Occupational Health and Safety Specialists and Technicians” (29-9010 in the 2010 SOC) in the major group “Healthcare Practitioners and Technical Occupations” (29-0000). Four detailed occupations moved across minor groups: “Teaching Assistants, Postsecondary” (25-9044, formerly 25-1191), “Dental Hygienists” (29-1292, formerly 29-2021), “Computer Numerically Controlled Tool Operators” (51-9161, formerly 51-4011), and Computer Numerically Controlled Tool Programmers (51-9162, formerly 51-4012).

Checking these soc codes that have major group changes in our BCAT\_SOC crosswalk table.
