## **RECOMMENDATION**

TO ADD THE SOPHOMORE-LEVEL COURSE IN CRIMINOLOGY TO AREA F RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE SOCIOLOGY MAJOR

## **RATIONALE**

THIS RECOMMENDATION WAS ACTUALLY APPROVED BY THE COMMITTEE IN 1996, AS EVIDENCED BY THE MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE DATED NOVEMBER 6, 1997 (http://www.usg.edu/admin/comm/sociology/min11.97.html). The original proposal to the Board of Regents apparently was lost, since to date criminology has not been added to THE AREA F Recommendations. (http://www.usg.edu/admin/accaff/newcore/areaf/sociology.html) This proposal is to replace the earlier proposal.

THE ORIGINAL RATIONALE FOR ADDING CRIMINOLOGY TO THE AREA F RECOMMENDATIONS WAS THAT CRIMINOLOGY IS A SUB-DISCIPLINE OF SOCIOLOGY AND IS A SOCIOLOGY-BASED COURSE. THIS COURSE, THEREFORE, IS ACTUALLY A SOCIOLOGY COURSE EVEN THOUGH IT MAY BE LISTED USING THE CRJU DESIGNATION.
